Brodick	The Douglas, Brodick Brasserie Auchrannie, Arran Eco Savvy, Crofters	ON FOOT / BY BIKE: A short walk from the ferry terminal along the sea front. BY BUS No. 322 / 324
Cladach	Arran Botanical Drinks	ON FOOT / BY BIKE: A couple of miles walk from the ferry terminal along the sea front and Fisherman's walk or Cycle north on the A841 BY BUS No. 324
Corrie	Mara	ON FOOT / BY BIKE: 6 Miles from Brodick round the Arran Coastal Way or Cycle A841 BY BUS No. 324
Lamlash	Glen Isle Hotel, COAST Arran High School, Stonewater Vegan B&B	ON FOOT / BY BIKE: 4 Miles from Brodick up the Fairy Glen or cycle South on the A841 BY BUS No. 323
Whiting Bay	Arran Community Land Initiative	BY BIKE: 8 Miles from Brodick South on the A841 BY BUS No. 323
High Kildonan	Woodside Farm	BY BIKE: 12 miles south from Brodick on the A841 BY BUS: No. 323
Balmichael	Arran Alpacas	BY BIKE: 8 miles North from Brodick on the A841 then The String Road BY BUS: No. 322
Blackwater foot	Blackwaterfoot Lodge Bellevue Farm	BY BIKE: 11 miles North from Brodick on the A841 then The String Road BY BUS: No. 322
Machrie	Cafe Thyme	BY BIKE: 11 miles North from Brodick on the A841 then The String Road BY BUS No. 324 or 322 to Blackwaterfoot then 324 to Machrie
